## Objectives

S-BPM ONE is the primary conference on topics related to subject-oriented business processes. S-BPM ONE's intention is to support an open discussion about integrated concepts and systems in business process management. The conference will bring together practitioners reporting on successfully running business processes, programmers demonstrating newly implemented concepts including open source programs, and researchers presenting new ideas as well as sound concepts resulting in standards.

## Type of Submissions

We solicit the following types of papers:

- Scientific results
- Application scenarios, best practices in process management, and success stories
- Educational concepts
- Description of tools and implementations

Submitted articles must not have been published or submitted elsewhere. Submission language is English.

## Proceedings

All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed anonymously by at least two independent referees from the international program committee. All accepted papers will be published in the proceedings of the conference, which will appear in Springer's Communications in Computer and Information Science series (pending approval).

All submissions will be handled through the Conference Management System (CMS), which can be found on the conference webpage (<http://www.s-bpm-one.org/>). It is not possible to submit papers through other ways like e-mail. All papers must be formatted according to the Springer's Communications in Computer and Information Science style. Individuals can appear as co-authors in several papers, but can only present one paper at the conference.

## Scope

S-BPM has become one of the most widely discussed approaches for process professionals. Its potential particularly lies in the integration of advanced information technology with organizational and managerial methods to foster and leverage business innovation, operational excellence, and intra- and inter-organizational collaboration.

S-BPM as a discipline is characterized by a straightforward approach towards the analysis, modeling, implementation, execution, and management of interaction patterns with an explicit stakeholder focus. However, S-BPM also embraces further themes pertaining to the engineering and management of systems and organizations, particularly with respect to the areas of interaction culture, process-aware information systems, strategic alignment, and governance structures.

The wide application areas and the immediate impact of S-BPM present an exciting opportunity for business and education practitioners to contribute to the knowledge in this area. Contributions may cover the design of innovative process-oriented artifacts or theories about the application, appropriation, and usage consequences of S-BPM artifacts in the organizational practice.
